YOUR COMMITMENT

Our partners play a crucial role in supporting emerging leaders by providing an invaluable personal and professional development experience through the Public Allies apprenticeship program.

They partner with Public Allies to create a well-defined position description with significant responsibilities and measurable objectives within a positive and supportive work environment. You'll also provide your Ally with direct supervision, support, and reporting on their service objectives.

Our partners pay a portion of the \$15,950 living stipend (exact amount varies site to site) for the 10-month apprenticeship. Organizations interested in hosting multiple Allies may qualify for a reduced cost per Ally.
